- A. The Falcon Motor club will organise a National B status Car Trial on Sunday 17th February 2008 at Home Farm, Great Brickhill. Map Ref :-165/906315.
- B. The meeting will be governed by the general Regulations of Motor Sport Association Ltd. (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FISA), the supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event.

- D. The National B event is open to fully elected members of the organising Club plus members of the following invited Clubs:-

BTRDA Cambridge Car Club Herts County A & AEC Chelmsford
Motor Club Stroud & District Motor Club Tunbridge Wells Motor Club Ltd
West Suffolk Motor Club Coventry & Warwick Motor Club Motor Cycle Club Ltd.

Plus registered contenders for the 2008 MSA British Car Trial Championship, The Edward Fox Printers BTRDA Car Trials Championship and the BTRDA Allrounders Championship 2008 and the Association of Central Southern Motor Clubs Car Trial Championship 2008.

- E. All National B event competitors must produce a valid club membership card and relevant Competition Licence.
- F. The event is a round of the 2008 MSA British Car Trial Championship, the Edward Fox Printers BTRDA Car Trial Championship 2008 the BTRDA Allrounders Championship and the ACSMC Car Trial Championship 2008.
- G. The programme of the meeting will be:-Scrutineering starts at 8.30 am. (Any competitor not signed on by 9.45 am may be excluded.) The first car starts at 10.00 am.
- H. Public roads will not be used. There will be at least 6 sections on private land and hopefully 4 runs at each section. The entry may be split into groups starting at different hills.

I. All cars must comply with the MSA vehicle and tyre regulations and carry a current MOT certificate if applicable. The event will consist of 4 classes as follows:-

- Class 1: 2WD PRODUCTION CARS-CARRYING NO BALLAST
2 wheel production cars, first registered on or after 12 years prior to 1 January 2008 taxed for road use, carrying no ballast, no modifications and driven to the venue. It is permitted to fit a sump guard which, complete with fittings, must not weigh more than 10kg
Minimum tyre pressures on driven wheels.(See notes 1 & 2)
FWD cars 20psi
FE RWD cars 16psi
RE RWD cars 24psi
- Class 2: FWD PRODUCTION CARS
Front wheel drive production cars not eligible for class 1.
Minimum tyre pressures on driven wheels. (See notes 1 & 2)
up to 1200cc 12psi
up to 1400cc 14psi
over 1400cc 16psi
- Class 3: RWD PRODUCTION CARS.
Rear wheel production cars not eligible for class 1.
Minimum tyre pressures on driven wheels.(See note 1)
FE Sports cars up to 1800cc 16psi
FE Sports cars over 1800cc 22psi
RE cars up to 1300cc 20psi
RE cars over 1300cc 24psi
FE Saloon cars up to 1800cc 14psi }these cars must have an overall first
FE Saloon cars over 1800cc 20psi }gear ratio Numerically less than 17.1
- Class 4: MODIFIED PRODUCTION CARS AND KIT CARS
Production Cars modified beyond Regulations J85 TO J105 and modified up to the limits specified in J59 (classes 1-6)
Front engined Kit Cars to approved MSA specification.
Front engined Kit Cars modified beyond Regulations J85 to J105 and modified up to the limits specified in J59 class 7(c)(ACTC approved specification).
Minimum tyre pressures on driven wheels:(see Note 1)
FE RWD cars 22psi
RE RWD cars 26psi
FE Kit cars 24psi
FWD cars 18psi
- Class 5: 2 WHEEL DRIVE CARS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR CLASSES 1-4
Minimum tyre pressures on driven wheels: (see Note 1)
FWD cars 16psi
FE RWD cars 18psi
RE RWD cars 20psi
This class will not be included in the Index of Performance for overall position on the Event.
- Note 1 Any car fitted with a torque biasing differential or any other form of traction control as catalogued for that car will have tyre pressures set at 4psi above the specified class pressure.
- Note 2 Cars with an overall length of 166 inches and over in classes 1 and 2 may reduce tyre pressures by not more than 4psi, subject to an absolute minimum pressure of 12psi.
- Note 3 Tie Deciders :-1 competitor with the most clean sections , 2 furthest cleanest.
- Note 4 For Championship scoring purposes, Classes cannot be amalgamated.

J. Awards will be presented as follows:-

NATIONAL B

1st overall on index.	
1st in each class	(subject to 3 starters)
2nd in each class	(subject to 8 starters)
3rd in each class	(subject to 12 starters)
Best Lady	(subject to 4 starters)
Best Novice	(subject to 6 starters)
Best Falcon	(not being eligible for any of the above awards)
The BTRDA Crested Spoon	(awarded to the BTRDA member finishing highest in overall classification)

Awards will be presented at the end of the event, following publication of the results.

A Novice is someone who has not previously won an award at a trial, other than a Ladies Award.

K. The entry list opens on the publication of these regulations and closes on Mon 11th February 2008

The entry fees are as follows:-

National B Event : £23.00 if received by Mon 4th February 2008.
£26.00 if received after.

NOTE : A full refund will be given if entry is withdrawn in writing up to closing date.
