

Supplementary Regulations

For the Sportingtials.com JB TAYLOR sporting trial

1. Sportingtials.com will organise a National B permit sporting trial at Flaxhayes, Higher Farm, Woolminstone, Crewkerne, Somerset, TA18 8QP on Sunday 11th April 2010.
2. The Meeting will be governed by the General regulations of the M.S.A. Ltd (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting code of the FIA), These SR's and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
3. M.S.A. Permit number T.B.A. Championship Waiver of Permit Number T.B.A
4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club and members of the following invited clubs. B.T.R.D.A, NPTCC, 750 Motor Club, Holding an M.S.A. Competition License valid for the event. Club membership cards and competition licences, with drivers photograph attached will be inspected at signing on.
5. The event is a round of the **MSA and B.T.R.D.A. Sporting Trial championship.**
6. The event will be at Flaxhayes, Higher Farm, Woolminstone, Crewkerne, Somerset, TA18 8QP. Public Roads will not be used to link sections. There will be 8 to 10 tests on private land to be attempted 3 times. The entry will be split into groups starting at different hills to enable the programme to be completed.
7. Scutineering starts at 9-00 am. First test at 10-30 am.
8. Awards to be presented as follows. 2nd place awards for each class will be given depending on number of entries.
Best overall performance of the day: Driver and Passenger, The November Sporting Trial Award
Best Performance Red Class. Driver and Passenger
Best Performance Blue Class Driver and Passenger
Best Performance Green Class Driver and Passenger
A Special Award to be presented at the Organisers discretion.
9. The entry list opens on the publications of these SR's and closes on the 8th April 2010. **The entry fee is £35.00.** All entries must be completed on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. **Cheques made payable to Sportingtials.com** and sent to the secretary of the meeting. Late entries will be accepted at an increased fee of £40.00 up to 9.30 on the day of the trial, providing the secretary has been notified by telephone beforehand. Entry fees will be refunded if the secretary of the meeting is notified by telephone or letter of a competitor's cancellation by 12 noon on the 10th of April 2010.

11. The maximum entry for the meeting is 50, the minimum is 22. Should the minimum figure not be met the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting.
12. Other officials are: Club Steward, Barrie Wright. Chief scrutineer, Ian Veale, Clerk of Course, John Ridley, Chief Marshall, Monty Peters.
13. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event, any protests to be made in accordance with 05.1.
14. Competitors will be identified by numbers, which will be provided at signing on.
15. All other GR's of the M.S.A. apply as written.
16. No person will drive a competing car on the site except the authorised competitor.
17. All competing cars must be fitted with an effective silencer. A noise test may be carried out
18. The use of motorcycles or quad bikes on the site is restricted to authorised persons only.
19. A first Aider will be in attendance
20. Toilet facilities will be available
