

General BTRDA Ltd Championship Rules ("Rules")

ELIGIBILITY

1. Championships featured in these Rules are organised and administered by BTRDA Ltd ("BTRDA®") on behalf of The British Trial & Rally Drivers Association Ltd ("the Association") in accordance with the General Championship provisions of the MSA and BTRDA® and individual championship regulations for each discipline. The championships are open to members of the Association ("Member") but the number of entries that can be accepted for a championship may be limited. All competitors must display any decals supplied by BTRDA® and those of any sponsors of individual championships on all qualifying events. Entrants may be required to have their vehicle checked for eligibility.
2. BTRDA® selects a number of events organised by Motor Clubs in which registered championship entrants may compete in order to attain marks.
3. A list of qualifying events will be published in BTRDA® NEWS but the list is subject to alteration, deletion or variation, at the discretion of BTRDA®. Amendments, if any, will be published in BTRDA® NEWS and/or Championship Bulletins and/or the motoring press.
4. Championship entrants may choose which events to enter. It is unnecessary to advise BTRDA® of the events selected but championship entry must be signified on the Club Entry Form for each event in order that marks can be recorded.
5. It is the responsibility of entrants to obtain Supplementary Regulations for qualifying events.
6. A championship registration does not guarantee an entry to the qualifying events and BTRDA® cannot enter into any correspondence or discussion on the matter of event entries.

ENTRY

7. To enter a championship a Member must complete and sign the official Entry Form and deliver, post, or send it together with a cheque/P.O. covering the Entry Fee, as appropriate, to the official whose name and address is given on the Entry Form.
8. Eligibility for subsidiary Awards must be claimed on the Entry Form where provision is made.
9. Acceptance of entry will be acknowledged by the issue of a Green Card, which certifies entry, bears a registration number and date of receipt of the Entry Form by the official. This Card must be signed by the entrant and produced on request to a Championship Official at each qualifying event.

SCORING

10. Marks are scored according to achievement by the entrant in a qualifying event, in accordance with the rules governing the championship. With the exception of the Allrounders Championship it is unnecessary for members to claim marks as these are automatically calculated by the BTRDA® Marking Official from the Final Results of each event received from the promoting Club, unless otherwise stated in the championship regulations.
11. No marks will be credited to a Member for any event held prior to the date recorded on his/her Green Card.

RESULTS

12. Interim provisional results will be published from time to time. Final results will be published as soon as practicable after the last event in the championship.

AWARDS

13. All Challenge Trophies and other principal awards are presented at the Annual Luncheon, Trials Dinner or, in the case of major sponsored championships, at special presentations that may be arranged. Challenge and other perpetual Trophies remain the property of the Association but may be retained by the winner for nine months from the date of the Official Presentation, providing they are collected at that function by the member in person, or his/her nominee; they must be returned to the BTRDA® upon request.

FORCE MAJEURE

14. If by reason of postponement or cancellation of an event or events forming a part of the championship referred to in this document, or if by reason of any alteration or suspension or annulment of results arising from an event or events forming part of the said championship, or if in the opinion of BTRDA® an event or events should be excluded from any such championship, or if in the opinion of BTRDA® an event or other events should be included, BTRDA® may either cancel the championship in question or modify or vary any part of the terms thereof as BTRDA® may in its sole discretion think fit. In either of such cases, no subscription or entry fees will be refunded. The decision of BTRDA® is final and binding.

ANNULMENT OF GREEN CARDS

15. (A) Any entrant ceasing to be a Member by reason of Rule 5 of the Association Rules shall automatically forfeit all points (if any) scored up to and including the date of loss of membership.
(B) Where a cheque for an entry fee as referred to in Rule 7 above is not met by the entrant's bank within 14 days of the same being presented for payment by the Association, then a Green Card already issued shall automatically be cancelled with effect from the expiration of the said 14 days and all points (if any) scored up to that date shall be forfeited.

QUERIES / DISPUTES

16. In the event of a query regarding a championship, please contact the specialist committee concerned. Any subsequent protest regarding that championship must be referred in writing to the BTRDA® panel of stewards via the BTRDA Ltd Company Secretary within time limits in accordance with the MSA Year Book.

BTRDA® ALLROUNDERS, supported by Richard Egger Insurance 2010 Championship Regulations

This Gold Star® Championship is organised in conjunction with the following BTRDA® championships: Autotest, Car Trial, Rally, Rallycross and Sporting Trial; together with any AutoSOLO to which BTRDA® has been invited, and any National A or National B Autocross, Sprint and Hill Climb.

The Allrounders 2010 championship is open to Members who indicate their registration on the Championship Entry Form for 2010. Acceptance of entry will be acknowledged by the issue of a Green Card, which certifies entry, bears a registration number and date of receipt of the Entry Form and Registration fee by the official. This Card must be signed by the entrant and produced on request at each qualifying event. Only registered contenders may score points at a qualifying event. Should any Member not indicate registration at the time of joining BTRDA® he/she may still register for Allrounders 2010 by applying in writing to the Championship Secretary and enclosing the Registration Fee. Points would then be allocated from the date of receipt of written registration. Competitors will be provided with Championship decals, at least one of which must be displayed in a prominent place on the car for points to be scored in the Championship.

TITLE and JURISDICTION

1. The Championship is organised and administered by BTRDA Ltd in accordance with the General Championship prescriptions of the MSA and these championship regulations. The championship is subject to the General BTRDA Ltd Championship Rules.

ELIGIBILITY

2. In addition to Drivers, Co-drivers are eligible for points in both rally groups. In any other groups as defined in 9 below these competitors must compete as drivers.
3. Vehicles must comply with the MSA Vehicle and Safety Regulations appropriate to the event entered.

QUALIFYING EVENTS

4. With the exception of "invitation by qualification" events such as the Car Trial and Sporting Trial Finals, all events qualifying for all BTRDA® championships within the calendar year (1 January - 31 December) will also be qualifying events for the Allrounders Championship. Additional events may be selected, of which notice will be given in BTRDA® NEWS. Events for the Speed Group G will be any Autocross, Sprint and Hill Climb of National A or National B Status. Events for the AutoSOLO Group H will be any AutoSOLO to which BTRDA® has been invited. Entrants may choose which of the events to enter and it is unnecessary to advise BTRDA Ltd in advance of the events selected.
5. It is the responsibility of entrants to obtain Supplementary Regulations and Entry Forms for qualifying events direct from the promoting Clubs. BTRDA Ltd cannot enter into any correspondence or discussion on the matter of event entries.

CLASSES

6. For the purpose of this championship there will be no separate classes. In each of the qualifying rounds selected entrants must enter the appropriate class.

SCORING

7. In Groups A, B, C, D, F, G and H (as defined in 9 below) points will be awarded according to the position in CLASS as shown on the official event results, and in Group E (as defined in 9 below) points will be awarded according to the position in CLASS in accordance with the BTRDA® Rallycross Championship scoring system after calculation by the Rallycross Marking Official from the official event results. The following formula - calculated to 2 decimal places - will be applied:

$$\frac{20}{(\text{number of starters in class} + 1)} \times [(\text{number of starters in class minus class position}) + 1]$$

EXAMPLES

$$\text{3rd out of a class of 9} = \frac{20}{(9 + 1)} \times [(9 - 3) + 1] = 2 \times 7 = 14$$

$$\text{1st out of class of 6} = \frac{20}{(6 + 1)} \times [(6 - 1) + 1] = 2.86 \times 6 = 17.16$$

8. POINTS NEED NOT BE CLAIMED for events included in Groups A, B, C, D, E, F and H as defined in 9 below as these will be awarded automatically by the Championship Secretary once published results are received from the Clubs. POINTS from events included in Group G as defined in 9 below MUST BE CLAIMED WITHIN 28 DAYS of each event. **Claims should be made to Steve Layton, 9 Brookside Drive, Catshill, Bromsgrove, Worcs. B61 9LD.** A copy of the event final results together with an entry list should be sent with the claim. No claims will be accepted after 31 December in the championship year.

9. The best **SIX** performances gained from **AT LEAST THREE** different Groups with no more than **THREE** from any Group (defined below) will count:

Group A - BTRDA® Championship Autotests	Group F - BTRDA® Championship Sporting Trials
Group B - BTRDA® Championship Car Trials	Group G - Speed (comprising any National A or National B Autocross, Sprint and Hill Climb)
Group C - BTRDA® Championship Rallies (Forest)	Group H - AutoSOLO
Group D - BTRDA® Championship Rallies (Asphalt)	
Group E - BTRDA® Championship Rallycross	

QUALIFICATION FOR AWARDS

10. To be eligible for an Award entrants must be classified in the Final Results as a Finisher in at least six qualifying events as defined in 9 above.

WINNER

11. The winner shall be the registered entrant gaining the most points as defined in 7 above.

TIES

12. Any ties will be decided in favour of the competitor who has gained the highest individual counting score, followed by the better second highest individual counting score, and so on until the tie is resolved. Should a tie still exist then the relevant awards will be shared between the tying competitors. Definition: The counting scores are the six which count towards a competitor's total score in accordance with Rule 9 above.

EXAMPLES 18.20 + 18 + **17.50** + 15.96 + 14 + 5.72 = 89.38 would beat
 18.20 + 18 + **17.16** + 15.96 + 14 + 6.06 = 89.38

AWARDS

13. No competitor may take more than one award other than the DAVIJON Trophy as defined in 15 below.

14. Champion	The PETER COOPER TROPHY and an award.
Runner-up	The DARBYSHIRE TROPHY and an award.
Third	The MARGOT YOUNG TROPHY and an award.
Fourth	The DUCKHAMS TROPHY and an award.
All other qualifiers	An award

The Champion will also receive a traditional BTRDA® Gold Star®.

15. The DAVIJON TROPHY, and an award, to the highest placed Allrounder who has used the same car on all qualifying events. Definition of 'same car' - identical specification with the exception of wheels and tyres which may be changed, and sump/tank guards which may be added or removed. The decision of the Allrounders Committee on 'same car' shall be final.
